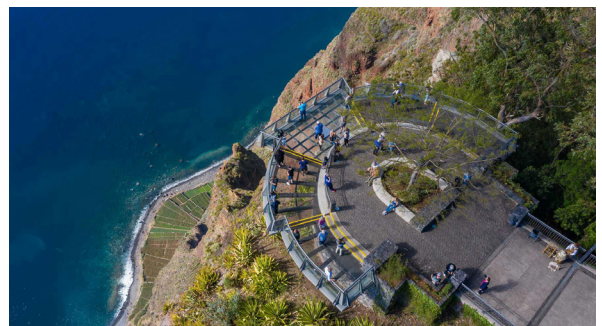
### HALF DAY ITINERARY - 4H

#### Route 1 – The Best of the Southwest Coast

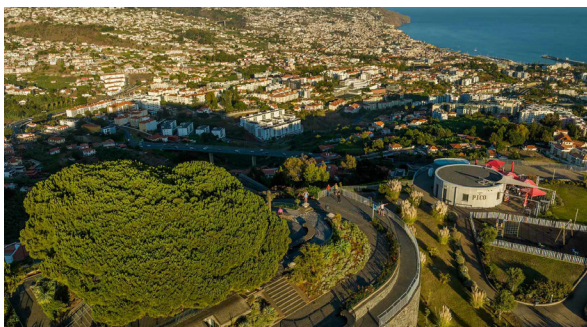
SIXT → Câmara de Lobos Bay → Cabo Girão → Pico dos Barcelos → Funchal → SIXT



**Câmara de Lobos Bay** - A charming fishing village on Madeira's south coast, famous for its colourful boats, traditional cuisine, and scenic bay once painted by Winston Churchill.



**Cabo Girão** - Europe's highest cliff at 580m, featuring a famous glass skywalk, panoramic views of Funchal and Câmara de Lobos, and a hub for adventure sports.



**Pico dos Barcelos Viewpoint** - Panoramic viewpoint over Funchal and the bay, with views of the Desertas Islands, leisure areas, and local shops.



**Funchal City Centre** - Free time to explore.

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### Route 2 – The Best of the North-East Coast

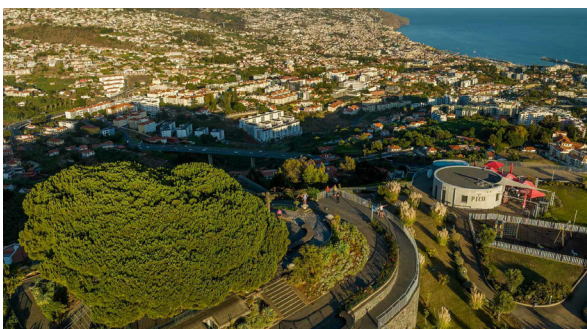
SIXT → Camacha → Santana → Faial Viewpoint → Funchal → SIXT



**Camacha** – a picturesque village at 700 m, known for its wicker crafts, traditional folklore, and scenic levada walks (irrigation channel trails).



**Santana** – Iconic triangular thatched houses in bright colours, symbolising Madeira's history, tradition, and rural architecture.



**Fortim do Faial** – Historic 18th-century fort and viewpoint on Madeira's north coast, offering panoramic views of Faial, Ponta de São Lourenço, and even Porto Santo on clear days.



**Funchal City Centre** – Free time to explore.





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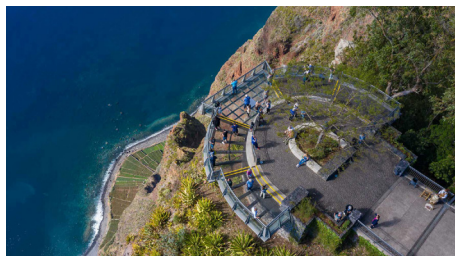
### FULL-DAY ITINERARY (7-8H)

#### West & North Coast - Sea, Mountains & Natural Pools

SIXT → Câmara de Lobos → Cabo Girão → Ribeira da Janela → Porto Moniz → Seixal Beach → Calhau da Lapa → SIXT



**Câmara de Lobos Bay** - A charming fishing village on Madeira's south coast, famous for its colourful boats, traditional cuisine, and scenic bay once painted by Winston Churchill.



**Cabo Girão** - Europe's highest cliff at 580m, featuring a famous glass skywalk, panoramic views of Funchal and Câmara de Lobos, and a hub for adventure sports.



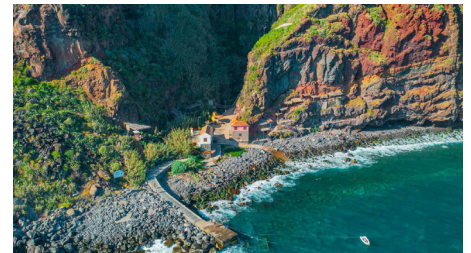
**Ribeira da Janela** - Dramatic north coast beach with pebble shore, striking rock formations including a natural "window," and lush surrounding landscapes.

### 2 DAY ITINERARY

#### Day 1 - West, North & Sunset

SIXT → Câmara de Lobos → Fajã dos Padres → Cabo Girão → Fanal → Ribeira da Janela → Porto Moniz → Seixal Beach → Ponta do Sol



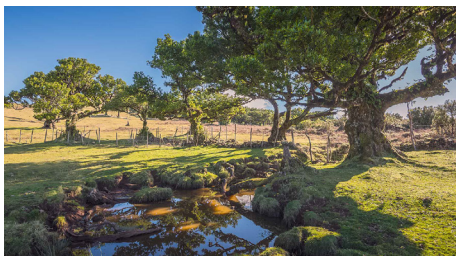
**Câmara de Lobos Bay** - A charming fishing village on Madeira's south coast, famous for its colourful boats, traditional cuisine, and scenic bay once painted by Winston Churchill.



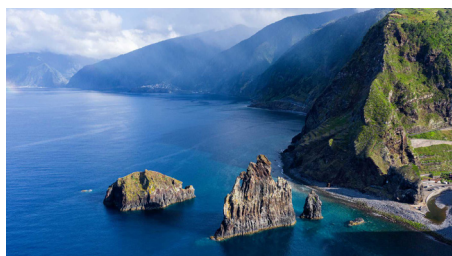
**Fajã dos Padres** - Secluded seaside paradise with turquoise waters, tropical gardens, a pebble beach, and access via cable car or boat.



**Cabo Girão** - Europe's highest cliff at 580m, featuring a famous glass skywalk, panoramic views of Funchal and Câmara de Lobos, and a hub for adventure sports.



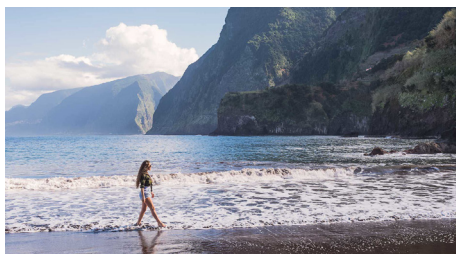
**Fanal Forest** - A magical and ancient forest in Porto Moniz, where misty landscapes and centuries-old trees create a truly unique atmosphere.



**Ribeira da Janela** - Dramatic north coast beach with pebble shore, striking rock formations including a natural "window," and lush surrounding landscapes.



**Natural Pools of Porto Moniz** - Volcanic seawater pools on Madeira's north coast, offering safe swimming, panoramic views, and full facilities for a relaxing family-friendly experience.



**Seixal Beach** - A black sand beach on Madeira's north coast, framed by green cliffs, offering calm waters, water sports, and easy access to nearby attractions.



**Ponta do Sol** - sunniest spot on Madeira's southwest coast, perfect for beaches, nature, and breathtaking sunsets.



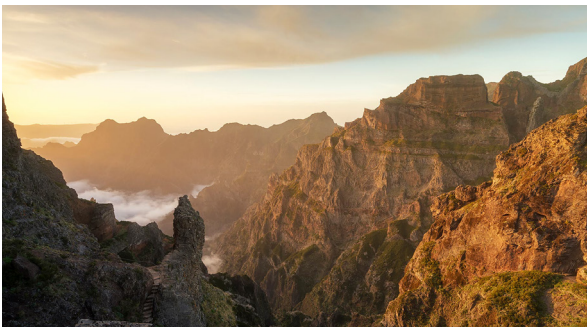


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### Day 2 – Mountains & East Coast

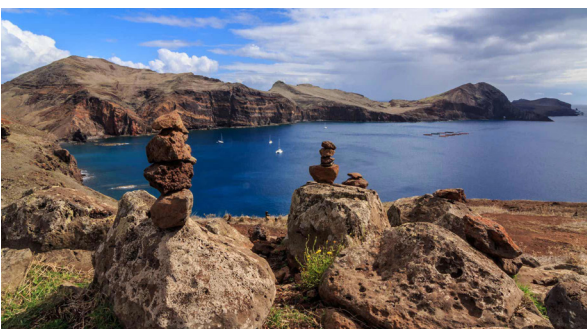
Pico do Areeiro → Santana → Ponta de São Lourenço → Machico → SIXT



**Pico do Areeiro** - Madeira's third-highest peak (1,818m) with panoramic mountain and ocean views, famous for sunrise vistas and hiking trails.



**Santana** - Iconic triangular thatched houses in bright colours, symbolising Madeira's history, tradition, and rural architecture.



**Ponta de São Lourenço** - Easternmost tip of Madeira with dramatic volcanic landscapes, rare flora and fauna, and a scenic 6km hiking trail.



**Machico** - historic town where Madeira was first discovered, featuring a scenic bay, cultural landmarks, and panoramic Atlantic views.



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### ↗ Driving Tips

- Practice defensive driving on mountain roads.
- Avoid high speeds in foggy areas.
- On Madeira's steep descents, try to avoid continuous braking.

Using the appropriate gears helps ensure a smoother drive.

On longer descents, short breaks can help maintain the good performance of the brakes.

### ↗ Time Estimates

- Time spent at each stop may vary depending on traffic and your preferences.
- At popular viewpoints (Cabo Girão, Pico do Areeiro), arriving early helps avoid crowds and makes the most of the views.

Note: Some attractions may have entrance fees or may be affected by weather conditions - please check in advance.

### ↗ Parking

- Most locations offer free or low-cost parking.
- At the busiest spots, there may be some waiting time during peak hours.
